Submitting your idea is easy! Follow these three steps:



▶ **Register to the platform** of ONE of the existing POWER cities and go to the section “Submit and vote on ideas in the POWER Idea Contest for Sustainable Communities” [Jerusalem](#), [Leicester](#), [Milton Keynes](#), [Sabadell](#)

▶ **Describe your sustainable idea:**

- Explain briefly (1-2 sentences) the sustainability problem that you want to solve
- Describe your solution (at least 3-4 sentences)
- Show how your idea is applicable to the local context in the POWER city that you have chosen
- Show how your idea is applicable to the context of Lisbon (or another city of your choice)

▶ **Share your idea** with your personal network and ask them to vote and comment on your idea. Integrate their feedback and improve your proposal. Win the chance to develop further and implement your idea.
